Heritage College Board of Governors Renews Director General's Mandate



The Board of Governors of Heritage College is pleased to announce that, at its most recent meeting on November 26, 2007, it voted unanimously to renew the mandate of Director General Claude J. Chénier for a third five-year term, to take effect on July 1, 2008.

Mr. Chénier was first appointed Director General of the College in July, 1998 while in his second term there as Academic Dean. Prior to being appointed Academic Dean in 1991, he had served Heritage as Director of Corporate Affairs and Communications since 1990 and as Director of Student Services/Secretary General since 1988. Mr. Chénier originally joined the staff at Heritage in 1980 as a guidance counselor.

Mr. Chénier has been serving as Chair of the Table Éducation Outaouais since 2003 and is a member of the Board of Administrators of the Université du Québec en Outaouais. He also sits on a number of regional and provincial committees. His commitment to international exchanges has resulted in, among other programs, an annual summer English Second Language program at Heritage College for students from Colombia.
