

Cégep Heritage College and International Pilot Academy Announce a New Partnership

Gatineau, December 18, 2017 – During a ceremony held today at Aéroport Exécutif de Gatineau-Ottawa, Cégep Heritage College and International Pilot Academy (IPA) announced a partnership to launch a new English Flight Training Program, starting in January 2018.

The program will allow Canadian and international students to register to one of the [various programs offered by IPA](#) and obtain the corresponding certification from Transport Canada. International Pilot Academy will be responsible for the Flight School and Cégep Heritage College for the Ground School.

The City of Gatineau through ID Gatineau was instrumental in acting as facilitator for the project. The Mayor of Gatineau, Maxime Pedneaud-Jobin who was in attendance stated that “The project will help increase the level of activity at the Aéroport exécutif de Gatineau-Ottawa and demonstrate that the city’s annual investment in the airport has a positive economic impact for the region.”
