## Heritage College Board of Governors Elects New Executive

The Board of Governors of Heritage College is pleased to announce the results of its annual elections held on November 27, 2002. **Pierre Roberge** of Hull was elected by acclamation to his first term as Chair of the Heritage Board, replacing outgoing Chair **Jennifer Mulligan** of Hull, Board representative for graduates of the career program sector. Monsieur Roberge is Director of the Development Bureau and Advisor to the Rector of the Université du Québec en Outaouais. He joined the Heritage College Board in January, 2002 as the regional university representative and has served as an elected member of the Executive Committee of the Board since February.

At that same meeting, **Anna Magnani** of Gatineau, regional enterprise representative since 1997, was re-elected by acclamation to her second term as Vice-Chair of the Board. **Jim Van de Vyvere** of Wakefield, a Heritage College faculty representative from the Liberal Arts department, was re-elected to a second term on the Board Executive Committee and pre-university program graduate representative **Jonathan Clarkin** of Aylmer was elected to the Executive for the first time.

The 19-member Heritage College Board of Governors includes representatives from the socio-economic community served by the College who are appointed by the Minister of Education, as well as elected members and Board appointees from the student body, parents, graduate students and from the various College employee associations.
