Heritage College Fall 2006 Honour Roll

Heritage College is proud to announce that 235 students have qualified for the Fall 2006 semester Honour Roll and extends hearty congratulations all of them for their outstanding achievements. These outstanding students represent 25.7 percent of the overall student population at Heritage during the Fall 2006 semester.

Honour Roll students at Heritage College are recognized by means of three distinct categories. An **Honour** student is a full-time student who, in a given semester, has attained an average of 80-89%, has completed the full-time load of courses as specified in the profile for that student's particular program, and has neither failed, nor failed to complete, a course. A **Dean's Honour** student has met all of the same criteria, while achieving an average of 90% or more. A student achieving **Academic Merit** status must also be a full-time student and attain an average of 90% or more without failures or incomplete courses in a given semester, but does not have to follow a full-time load of courses as specified in the profile for that student's program.

The attached lists indicate each honour student's category of achievement and include exceptional students from career and pre-university diploma (DEC) programs offered by the College (representing 24 percent of the total number of students in DEC programs at Heritage in the Fall 2006 semester), as well as from attestation (AEC) programs offered by the Centre for Continuing Education (representing 40.7% of the total number of students in AEC programs in the Fall 2006 semester).
