Heritage College congratulates four of its Science students for scoring in the top 25% of over 5,700 entrants competing in the ninth annual Canadian Open Math Challenge run by the Centre for Education in Mathematics and Computing at the University of Waterloo. **Jonathan Plumpton, Emma Brittain Boisvert, Trevor Sabourin, and Robert Turnbull**, all of whom are residents of the Aylmer sector of Gatineau, were awarded Certificates of Distinction for their outstanding efforts.

The Canadian Open Math Challenge takes place each year to provide extra-curricular mathematics competition for senior level, and motivated younger, Math students from across Canada. It also acts as a qualifying paper for the Canadian Mathematics Olympiad.
