Heritage College Student wins 2008 RBC Aboriginal Student Award

Heritage College is very proud to announce that third-year Early Childhood Care and Education student Katrina Whiteduck (from the Hull sector of Gatineau) was one of eight Aboriginal students from across Canada to have been awarded a scholarship by the Royal Bank of Canada (RBC) in 2008.

As an award winner of the RBC Aboriginal Student Awards Program, Katrina will receive up to \$4,000 for each academic year, for a maximum of two years at college or four years at university, to use towards tuition, textbooks, supplies and living expenses.

Congratulations to Katrina on becoming one of the 77 full-time students to have received an Aboriginal Student Awards scholarship in Canada since the award program began 14 years ago.
