Bilingual instruction programs in Accounting and Management: A Collaboration between Heritage College and Cégep de l'Outaouais

The Accounting and Management programs at Heritage College and Cégep de l'Outaouais recently highlighted the success of the first graduating classes produced through a joint project which is unique in Quebec, and which assures training focused on the bilingualism of its students.

For the students of Heritage College, this project is integrated into the three-year Accounting and Management Technology career program. In addition to their regular French Second-Language courses, an immersion period of instruction is offered to students, off-campus. In fact, each student has the opportunity to follow the “Business Law” course in French (“Droit des affaires”) at Cégep de l'Outaouais. This innovative exchange project is also accessible to all of the francophone students enrolled in the “Gestion de commerces” and “Techniques de comptabilité et gestion” programs at Cégep de l'Outaouais, who, in turn, come to Heritage College to follow that course in English.

This unique collaboration enables students to better respond to the demands of the employment market in the Outaouais and in the National Capital regions, and provides them with world-wide mobility.
