Winners of Heritage College Creativity Contest 2009

Congratulations to the winners of the 2009 Heritage College Creativity Contest! Cansu Koç received the Grand Prize for her work of prose entitled, “Paris at My Fingertips.” This year’s Prose Prize went to Erica Cunningham for “Relative Insanity.” The co-winners of the Poetry Prize were Heather Baskerville for “Global Village” and Riteba McCallum for “Wien.” This year’s Frank Schreiner Prize for Humour was won by Sarah Adcock for “When Life Turns Upside-Down.” Sarah Marchand received the Graphic Art Prize for “Wormy 1.”

This marks the 33rd anniversary of the Creativity Contest at Heritage College as a forum for featuring the talents of its students. The prize-winning entries and those meriting “honourable mention” appear in the annual Heritage College Creative Arts Journal, *The First Edition*. Entries included works of short fiction, poetry and graphic arts (including photographs, illustrations and sketches). The editorial board commented, “This year, the quality of submissions to the Creativity Contest was perhaps as high as we have ever received—it was indeed a challenge to select the final winners in each category.”
