The Heritage College Bacchus Players drama group is presenting its seventh annual production, *The Blue Room*, from February 14 to 17 (inclusive) beginning at 7:30 p.m. each evening in the College auditorium.

In a departure from tradition, this year's production is for mature audiences only. *The Blue Room*, by British author Sir David Hare, follows a chain of sexual encounters between an intriguingly diverse selection of characters— including a prostitute, a cab driver, a politician, a model, an actress and an aristocrat—and the journey they take, individually and collectively, in their relationships, whether their relationships are love or lust.

Sir David Hare adapted the 1998 script for *The Blue Room* from Arthur Schnitzler's *La Ronde*, which was first performed in 1897. As well as being the co-founder of the Portable Theatre Company, Sir David Hare has directed films and written many other plays and screenplays.

The players involved in this year's production are Caitlin Emond, Laura Forsythe, Corey Larose, Ashley Latour, Jordan O'Byrne, Kyle O'Byrne, Graham Olson, Ingrid Smith, Steve Stransman and Alyssa Walker. The play is being produced by Caitlin Emond and directed by Jennifer Scrivens, who has been active on the Ottawa theatre scene for many years, both as a director and as an actor. This year's stage managers are Amy Cunningham and Laura Torontow.
