

2005 Euclid Math Contest Winners from Heritage College

Heritage College congratulates the 12 second-year Science students who participated in the University of Waterloo Euclid Math Contest this year. The top three Heritage participants, Emma Brittain Boisvert, Jonathan Plumpton and Trevor Sabourin (all from Aylmer) will receive Certificates of Distinction for scoring in the top 25 percent among over 14,000 Canadian contestants. Rounding out the top five scorers from Heritage are Thomas Lever and Erick Mendez-Cardenas (both from Aylmer), who will receive medals. Other students participating in this year's contest were: Guido Delgado of Aylmer, Marjorie Kinahan of Gatineau, Melissa Richardson of Wakefield, Abraham Bach, Julia Murphy Buske and Jamie Durham (all from Aylmer) and Jennifer Coulombe-Hallé of Gatineau.

Mathematics Department Coordinator Charlotte Huang noted that this year's group represented the largest number of Heritage students ever to participate in the Euclid Contest. In fact, Heritage College appears on the Honour Roll List for Quebec, ranking seventh.

The University of Waterloo Euclid Math Contest has taken place each year for the past 31 years to provide extra-curricular mathematics competition for senior level, and motivated younger, Math students from across Canada, to develop their mathematical problem-solving abilities. This year, over 1,100 schools participated.
