Heritage Nursing Teacher receives Pedagogical Award

The Provincial Association of Quebec Colleges' Nursing Teachers (AEESICQ), in collaboration with *Chenelière Éducation*, has granted its 2009 Pedagogical Document Award to Heritage College Nursing teacher Suzanne Larochelle.



Mrs. Larochelle won the award, which consists of a certificate, an engraved glass prism and a bursary, for creating a document entitled, *Lexicon English-French for Nursing Students at Heritage College*. The *Lexicon* helps Heritage Nursing students acquire and improve their French nursing terminology, thereby gaining greater confidence in their oral and written communications skills when interacting with the staff and patients in the Outaouais region's French-speaking hospitals.

The AEESICQ was created 24 years ago to support college nursing education. It comprises nursing teachers from the 42 colleges and six regional centres in Quebec. For the past five years, the Association has awarded pedagogical prizes in three categories: Pedagogical Document, Pedagogical Activity, and Contributions to the College's Community. In doing so, it recognizes the outstanding pedagogical activities developed by nursing teachers throughout the province.

Heritage congratulates Suzanne Larochelle on her achievement and her contribution to the success of its Nursing students.
