On October 15 2009, Heritage College announced the addition of these two new career programs that were initially to be offered on a provisional basis. Michelle Courchesne - Quebec Minister of Education, Recreation and Sports, has just advised Pierre Roberge - Chair of the Heritage College Board of Governors, that the Tourism Program (414.A0) as well as the Hotel Management Program (430.A0) can now be offered on a permanent basis.
