Subject: H1N1 Vaccine at Heritage

Hello,

Please note that vaccination for the H1N1 influenza will be available at Heritage College in room 170-171, between 8:00 am and 3:00 pm from Wednesday, November 25th, 2009 to Friday, November 27th **for the following groups of people:**

All Heritage College students (regular + cont. ed) **who are:**

- aged 19 years and under.
- are pregnant.
- have contact with young children aged 6 months and under.
- work in the health sector.
- are aged 20+, but have chronic diseases.
- are in contact with people with compromised immune systems.
- have chronic medical conditions requiring hospital care and regular follow-up.

Please note that students who reside in Ontario are not eligible.

Foreign students, or students from BC, for example, are eligible, as they are not close to their home province.

Students will need to bring their Quebec Health Card and their Student I.D. card to get the vaccine.

Please note that the vaccine is also available to staff, who do not reside in Ontario, and who fall in the at-risk categories:

- have chronic diseases.
- are pregnant.
- have contact with youngsters aged 6 months and under.
- have contact with people with compromised immune systems.
- are 65+ years of age.

Employees in the at-risk categories will need to bring their Quebec Health Card and their College employee I.D. card to get the vaccine.
