

Quebec Residency status needs to be proven

The Ministry of Education has instituted a law pertaining to college level studies and those who qualify for tuition-free education in Quebec. All students attending Heritage College must prove their Quebec residency. Your file indicates that you have not yet proven your status.

In order to benefit from tuition-free education, you must forward the necessary documents indicating your residency status. In the absence of these documents, you will be required to pay the \$1055.00* non-Quebec resident fee per semester. **Students will not be allowed to officially register (get a timetable, locker, i.d. card) unless your residency status has been regulated.** In a case where you or one of your parent's medical card is used as proof of residency, it first must be validated within our Heritage College system. Attached you will find additional explanations related to the attestation of Quebec Resident Status. Please notify us if you are a not a Quebec resident and have paid the out of province fees.
